

## APPLICATION - Two Undergraduate Majors in CALS

This application is for two CALS majors under the general CALS Bachelor of Science degree. This application **does not apply** to students who want two majors under two different degrees (refer to "Two Undergraduate Degrees in CALS" application). All requirements for both majors must be met with a minimum of 120 degree credits with at least 15 credits completed in each major that are not double-counted in the other major. Both majors must be completed, along with all university, college and degree requirements. Application must be submitted prior to earning 86 credits.

Student must complete the application AND submit a completed Eligibility Assessment for double majors and degrees form.
